### Important Notice

- As of fiscal year 2019, the dates and locations of some collection areas will change.
- From April 2019, the waste separation rules will change.

### Use the **5Rs** to reduce garbage

**Refuse:** avoid accepting items that will become unnecessary garbage.

**Reduce:** work to generate less garbage.

**Reuse:** take care to get repeated use out of things.

**Repair:** fix items for longer use.

**Recycle:** separate materials properly so that they can be recycled.

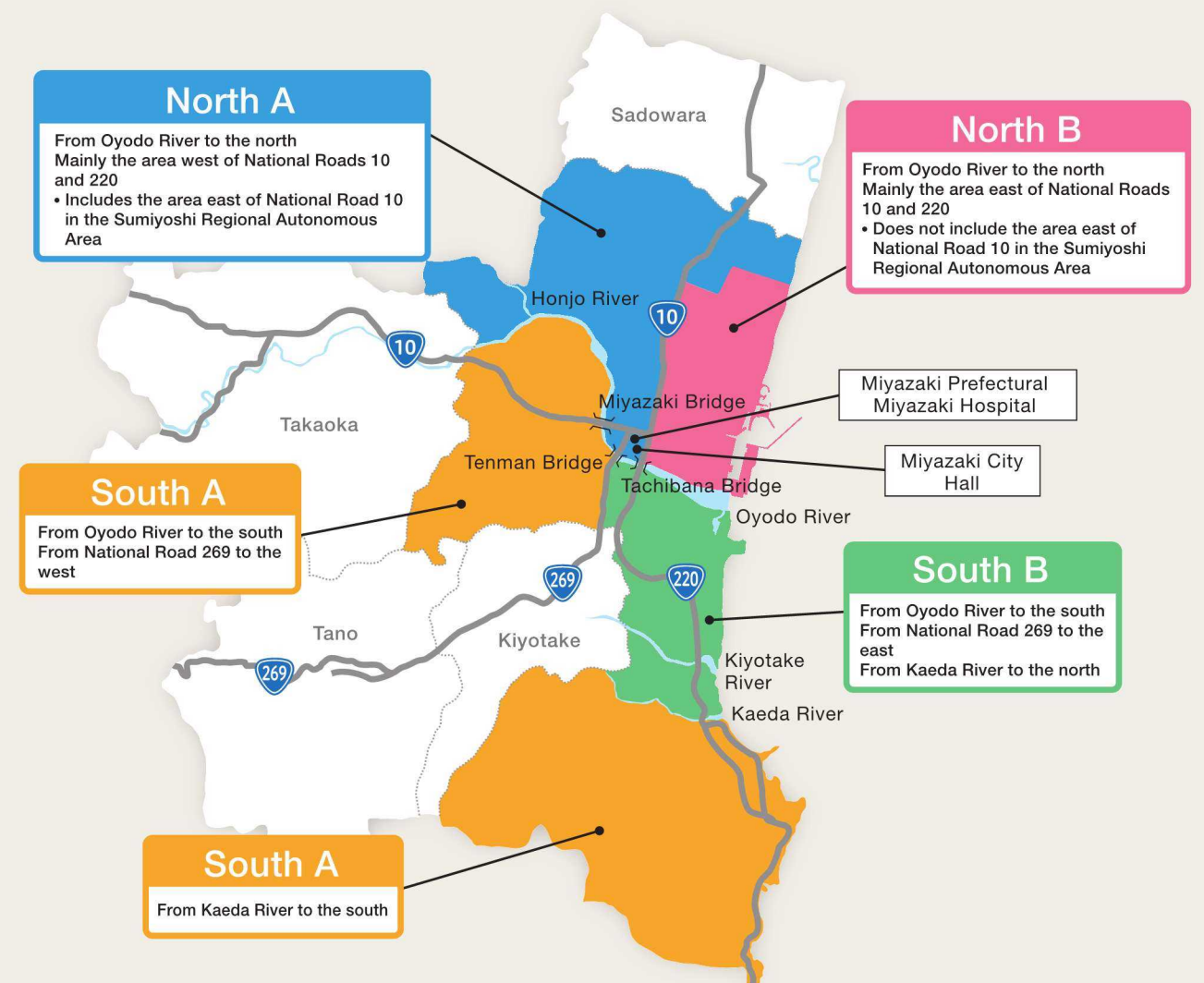

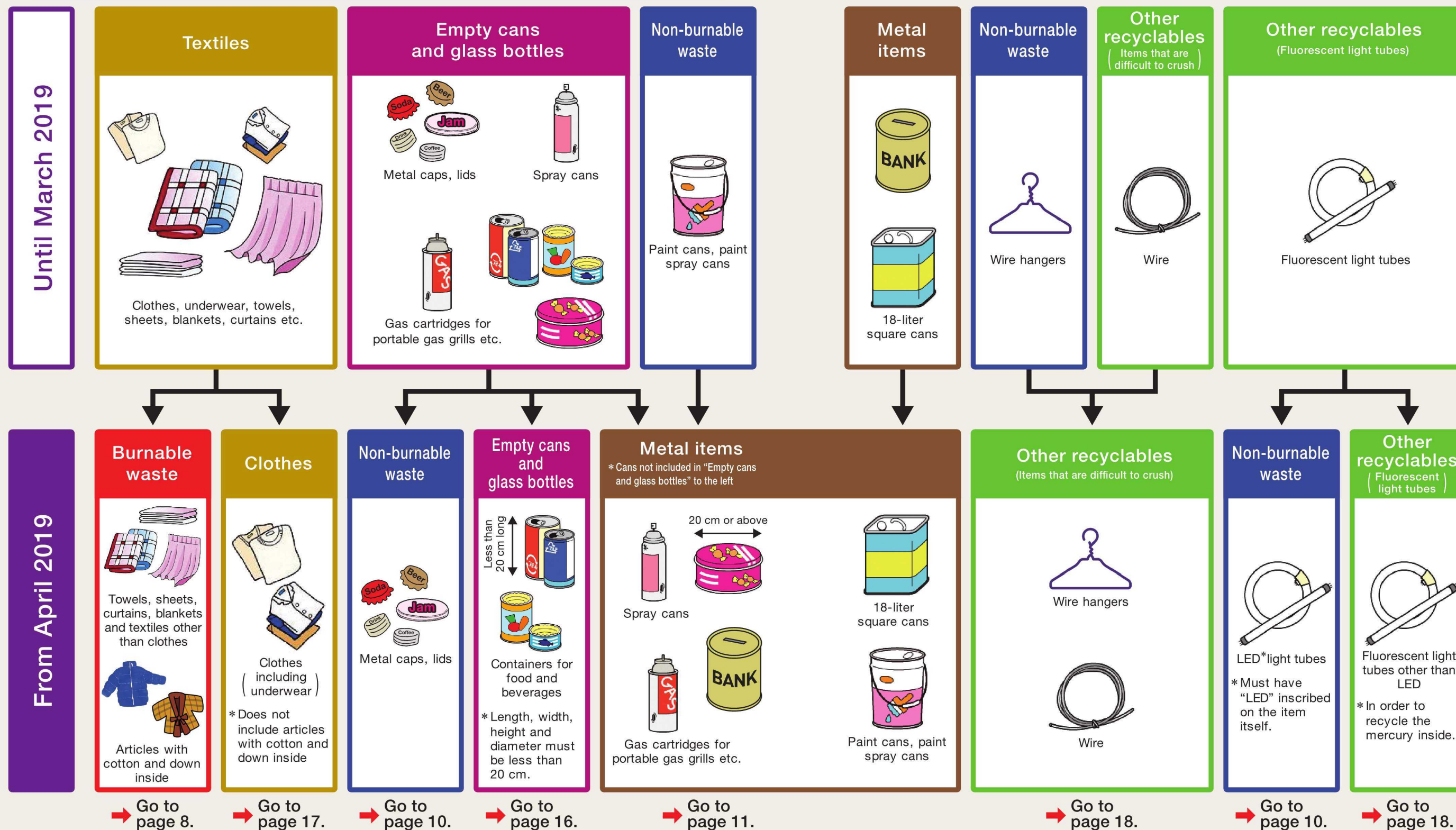




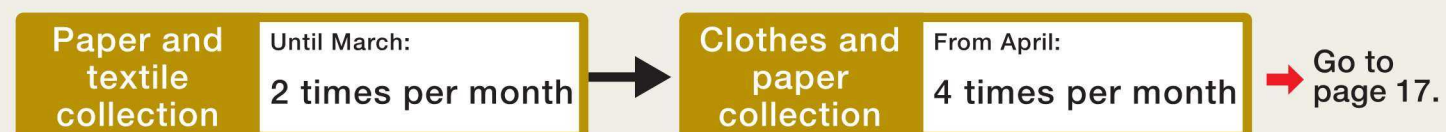

## Changes to the separation rules for garbage

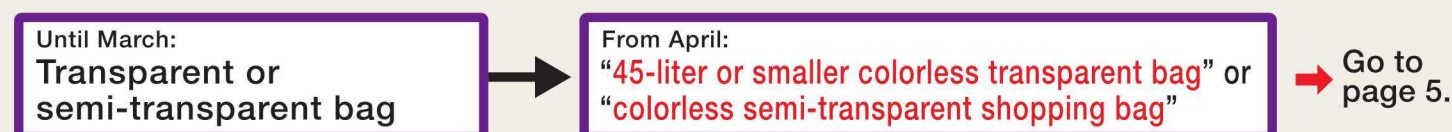
April to September 2019 is the transition period. Actual implementation is from October 1, 2019.

# Basic garbage disposal rules in Miyazaki City

## Basic garbage disposal rules

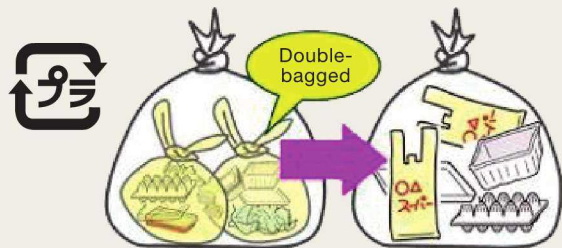
### Put out garbage by 8:30 a.m.

- Put the garbage in the designated collection place by 8:30 a.m.
- The collection time may change depending on the collected amount and schedule of the day.



### Follow the rules for disposing of garbage.

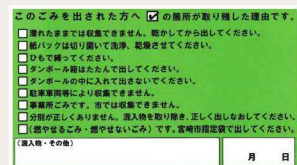
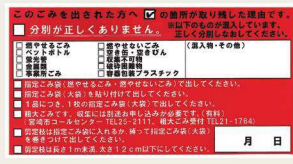
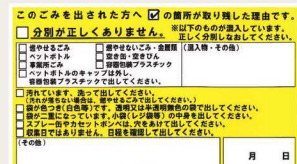
Disposal of garbage and recyclables depends on the type of item. For details, refer to this handbook.



Double-bagging makes it hard to confirm the contents of the bag.

### Refusal of garbage collection

- If the rules for disposing garbage are not followed, one of the following stickers will be put on the bags and the bags will not be collected.
- If your garbage is left, take it back home once to separate it correctly and put it out again.



### Do not put out more than 5 bags of garbage.

- If you want to dispose of more than 5 bags at one time, please bring the garbage to Eco Clean Plaza Miyazaki directly or contact a specified company.

### Put in the designated place.

- The garbage collection place is managed by the Residents' Association etc. For information about where the collection place is, ask a neighbor or the Residents' Association of your area.
- Please ask the collection management in your area if you want to put your garbage in a collection place other than the designated area.
- Moving or creating a collection place requires a permit.



### Bulk trash

- Anything over 1 m width, length or height is bulk trash. **→ Go to page 20.**
- Even if you cannot put the item into the designated bag, if it is less than 1 m, you can paste the designated **large bag** onto the item and put it out for collection. **→ Go to page 6.**

### Recyclables

- Wash and dry recyclables, such as plastic containers and packaging, PET bottles, empty cans and glass bottles, and paper packages, before putting them in a bag.
- You must take off and separate lids and caps.

## Types of designated bags

### Burnable waste Designated bag



Large bag..... 40 liters  
Medium bag..... 30 liters  
Small bag..... 20 liters  
Extra-small bag ... 10 liters

- Be sure to use the **Miyazaki City Designated Waste Collection Bag for Burnable Waste** (large, medium, small or extra small).

### Non-burnable waste Designated bag



Large bag..... 40 liters  
Medium bag..... 30 liters  
Small bag..... 20 liters  
Extra-small bag ... 10 liters

- Be sure to use the **Miyazaki City Designated Waste Collection Bag for Non-burnable Waste** (large, medium, small or extra small).

### Recyclables 45-liter or smaller transparent bag or semi-transparent shopping bag



White, cream or other color bags will not be collected.

## Garbage separation app

Miyazaki City Garbage Separation App can be used to check separation rules and set up collection date alerts from your smartphone.

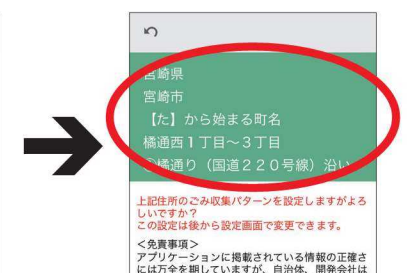

- Set up your region.** Choose your address from the list of prefectures.



- Set up alerts to your liking.** Get push notifications for garbage collection dates. Go to Menu → Settings to configure settings for alerts.

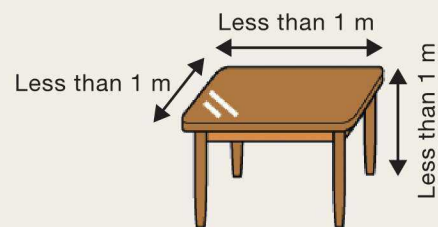

- There is no personal information needed.
- The application is free, but data charges incurred by using the application must be borne by the user.





# Garbage that cannot be bagged

- How to dispose of garbage that does not fit in the designated large garbage bag (for burnable and non-burnable waste). (Anything with a length, width or height of less than 1 m)



## Attention

Use a bag that is appropriate for the type of garbage. (1 bag per item)  
You cannot attach the designated garbage bag to a different large bag.

### Attach or cover

\* 1 bag per item



Example: Wooden box

Non-burnable waste large bag



Example: Futon

Fold and wrap until it is less than 1 m

### Umbrellas (exceptions)



The size of the bag does not matter.

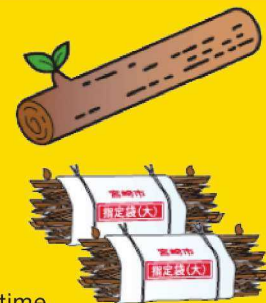
### Standards for collection of tree branches

Less than 1 m long, 12 cm thick or less

### If you have an excessive amount

Disposal method ① Spread the bags out through multiple collections (5 bags max per collection).

Disposal method ② Directly transport them to the Eco Clean Plaza Miyazaki (charge applies). Refer to page 26.



\* The normal collection schedule may be negatively impacted if there is too much garbage at one time.



# Garbage Separation Tips

### Plastic packaging with the recycling mark

→ Plastic containers and packaging



This is the mark to look out for!

→ Go to page 12.

### Disposable items like paper towels and chopsticks

→ If you use a cloth towel instead of a paper towel, you can reduce your garbage. Try to limit the usage of disposable items only to times when it is absolutely necessary.

### Food scraps

→ 80% of food scraps is water. If you squeeze it, you can reduce the weight. Try to peel the foods before you wash them to keep scraps from getting wet.

→ Go to page 8.



Why do we have so much garbage?



### Paper bags and candy boxes are recyclable paper.

→ Unlike receipt papers that cannot be recycled, these can be collected as recyclable paper.

→ Go to page 17.

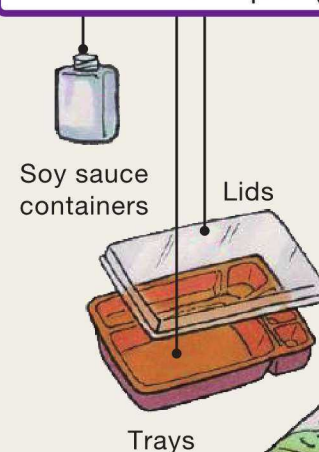
### Cartons

→ If you wash and dry them, six cartons can be turned into one roll of toilet paper.

→ Go to page 17.

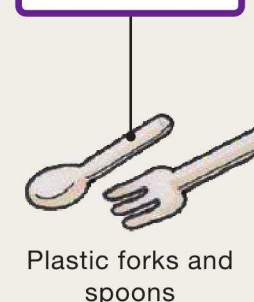

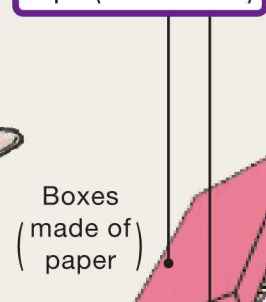

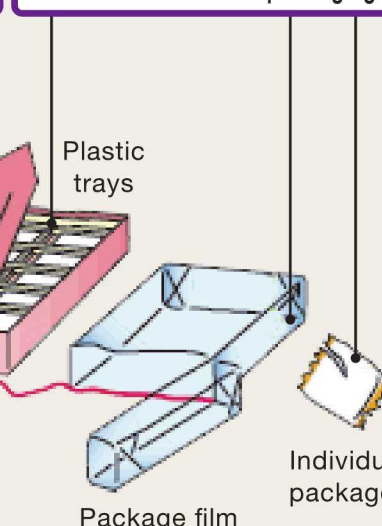

Make sure to squeeze out any water.



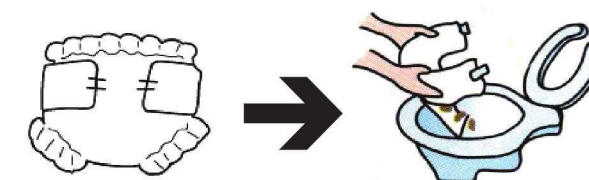
### Disposal of cooking oil **How to dispose**

- Put it out in the group collection of your residential area.
- Use the collection box at the relevant municipal facility.
- Absorb the oil with paper etc. or make the oil solid with a coagulant before disposal.



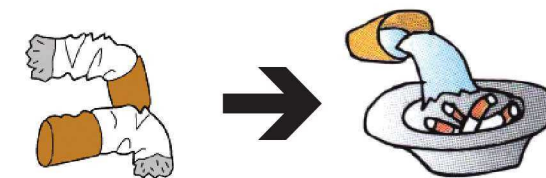
### How to dispose of paper diapers **Important**

Flush fecal matter down the toilet before disposal.



### Cigarette butts and fireworks **Important**

Make sure the flame is out and wet before disposal.

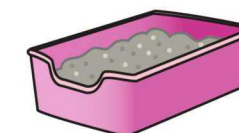

### Cat litter

Regardless of the labels, cat litter is burnable waste. Remove fecal matter and dispose of it little by little.

# Non-burnable waste

Collection: 1 time per month

## How to dispose of non-burnable waste

**How to dispose of dangerous items and breakables**

Wrap the broken items in paper and write "キケン (Danger)" on the outside.

**Ceramics (porcelain) and glass**

**Other**

Aluminum (tin) foil

Refer to page 6 for how to dispose of umbrellas.

**Designated garbage bag**

**Dangerous items**

LED light tubes

Use all of the fluid before disposing. No need to wrap in paper.

**Electric appliances\***

\* Use the specified collection boxes for some small electrical appliances. (Refer to page 19.)

**How to dispose of bowling balls (non-burnable waste)**

- Place the bowling ball inside the designated "Non-burnable waste" garbage bag.
- Put out the bag on the collection day for "Other recyclables."

\* Please let the Environmental Affairs Division know beforehand when and where you will put the garbage.

**Attention**

Refer to pages 22 and 23 for disposal of personal computers and items that fall under the Home Appliance Recycling Law.



# Metal items

Collection: 1 time per month

## Applicable items (items that consist mostly of metal with less than 5 mm thick)

**Extremely dirty or rusty items are non-burnable waste.**

**Pots and pans**

Frying pans

Kettles

Pots

Clay and glass pots are non-burnable waste.

**Cans or containers for food and beverage (20 cm or larger)**

(20 cm or above)

Any can or container with length, width, height or diameter of 20 cm or above

**Microwaves etc.**

Microwaves

Oil fan heaters

Heaters

Remove the kerosene.

Remove kerosene and batteries.

**Spray cans and gas cartridges (cans that are not for food)**

Make sure it is empty, then go outside and open a hole in the body of the can.

**Paint cans**

If there is still paint remaining, soak it up with paper etc. and dispose of it in burnable waste.

**How to dispose of metal items**

**45-liter or smaller transparent bag or semi-transparent shopping bag**

\* If objects less than 1 m in size do not fit into the bag, attach a note that says "金属類 (Metal items)."

# Plastic containers and packaging

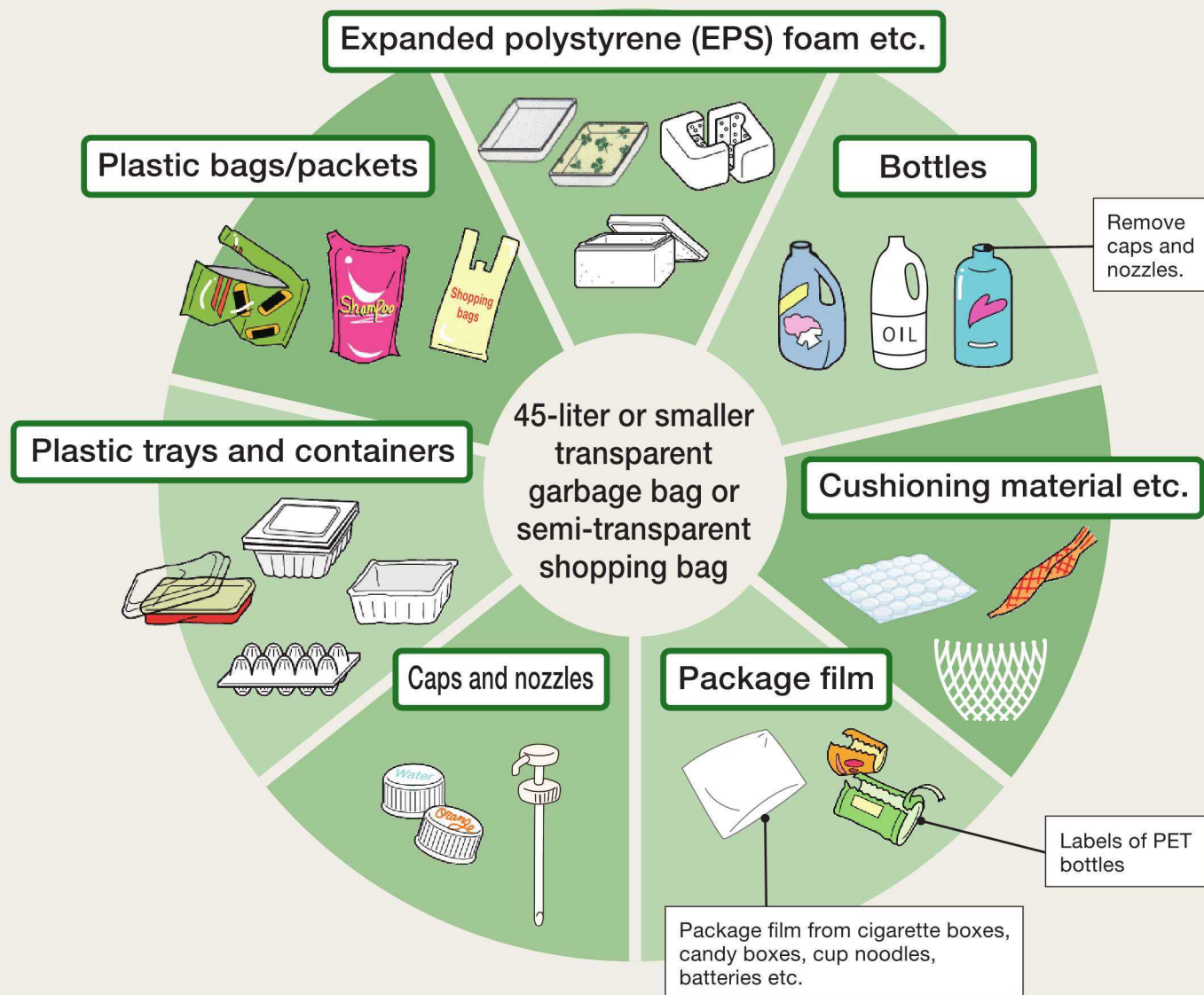
Collection: 1 time per week



&lt;Applicable items&gt;

- Items that have the recycling symbol for plastics
- Cushioning material (expanded polystyrene foam, air cushions etc.)

Note: These refer to the unneeded plastic containers and bags from which food or daily goods have been taken out.



## How to dispose of plastic containers and packaging

- ① Lightly wash or wipe the dirt off.



- ② Dry and put them in a 45-liter or smaller transparent garbage bag or semi-transparent shopping bag for disposal.



Dirty items are "Burnable waste."



### Attention

Please do not double-bag.



## How to dispose of plastic containers and packaging **Important**

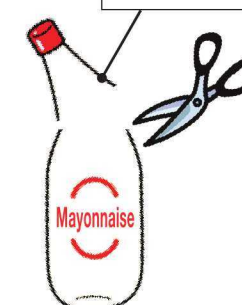
You do not need to take off stickers.



Put your finished oil containers upside down in the garbage box overnight so all the remaining oil drips out. That way, you can throw it away as it is.



Easy to wash if you cut it in half.

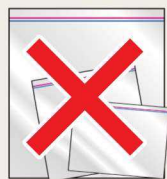

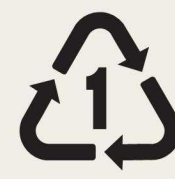

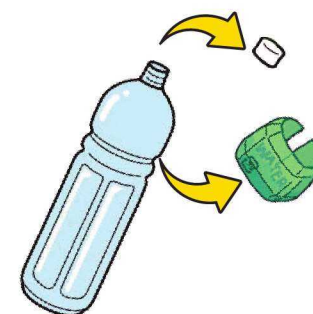

Dispose of them in a 45-liter or smaller transparent garbage bag or semi-transparent shopping bag.

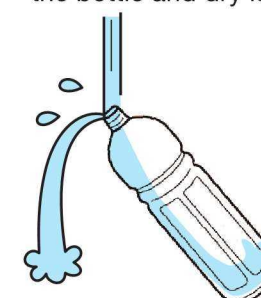


## How to dispose of PET bottles

② Lightly wash the inside of the bottle and dry it.



③ Put it in the bag without crushing it.

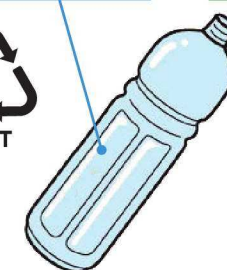

Collection: 2 times per month

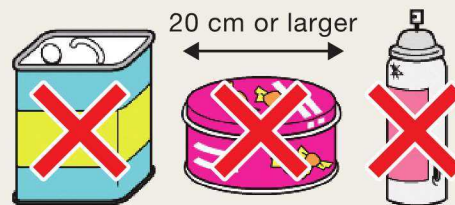
## ● Applicable items

## Empty cans

- \* Any item with a length, width, height or diameter of **less than 20 cm**
- \* Large cans, spray cans and gas cartridges belong with metal items.

## Empty glass bottles

Drink, food or medicine bottles.  
Excludes cream colored make-up bottles.

## How to dispose of cans and bottles

① Remove the cap.

- \* Remove also the can's tab.

② Lightly wash the inside and dry it.

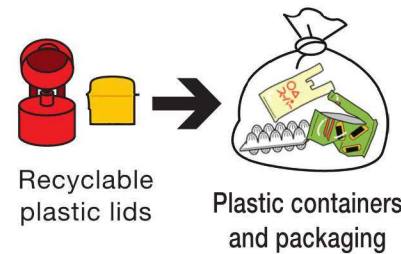
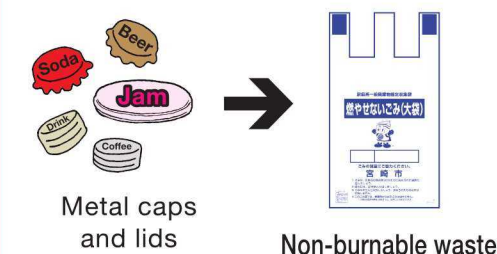
③ Put it in the bag without crushing it.

45-liter or smaller transparent garbage bag or semi-transparent shopping bag

Attention  
Do not put the cap in the same bag as the cans or bottles.

## Separation of lids, tabs and caps of cans and glass bottles

Caps and lids should be lightly washed and dried. Metal caps and lids go in "non-burnable waste." Plastic caps and lids go in "plastic containers and packaging."

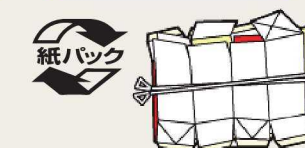

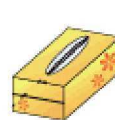

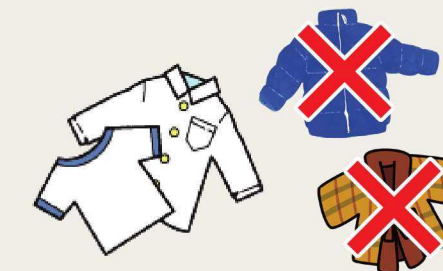

## How to dispose of clothes

45-liter or smaller transparent garbage bag or semi-transparent shopping bag



## How to dispose of paper

Tie them together with string by category.

If they might get wet from rain, put the tied bundle inside of a 45-liter or smaller transparent bag or semi-transparent shopping bag.

## Paper items that should be put with burnable waste

- ◆ Paper cups and yogurt containers (with water resistant paper)
- ◆ Receipts or other heat-sensitive paper, which get black if you scratch with fingernail.
- ◆ Fragrant paper (boxes of perfumes or detergents)
- ◆ Crimped postcards (postcards that get bigger once you pull back the front and back sheets)
- ◆ Carbon paper, non-carbon paper
- ◆ Paper with vinyl coatings (posters and postcards that reveal vinyl when ripped)
- ◆ Paper cartons with aluminum coating inside (soy milk and alcohol packs etc.)
- ◆ Paper coated or drawn with paint or ink
- ◆ Photos

## How to dispose of bulk trash

- ① Apply for bulk trash collection through the Miyazaki City Call Center (TEL. 25-2111).
- ② Purchase the bulk trash sticker from a store that offers them.  
\* Depending on the item, there are cases when we will directly visit to collect fees.
- ③ Adhere the bulk trash sticker to the item you applied to have collected. Place the item in the designated place by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day.

### Attention

- You can only apply for three items to be collected at one time.

- If you ask for collection of items that fall under the Home Electrical Appliance Recycling Law, you will need to purchase an electrical appliance recycling ticket before you apply.
