Burnable Garbage

Twice a week

Food waste

Plastic products

Leather goods

Clothing, etc.

Rubber products

Garden cuttings, leaves

Garden cuttings should be no longer than 1 meter and no thicker than 12 cm.

Caution

Items that do not fit into a large bag can be taped to or covered with a **large bag**—one type of item per bag—as long as it is within one meter in length, width, and height.

Caution

Do not double-bag garbage. Unclean items should be disposed of with **burnable garbage**.

PET beverage, seasoning, sake or other food bottles

Colorless, clear bottles only

* Dispose of colored or opaque bottles as **burnable garbage**.

Caution

Remove caps and labels. Dispose of colored or unclean bottles, and bottles with irremovable caps or labels as **burnable garbage**.

20 cm or less

Beverage/food cans less than 20 cm in any direction or diameter

Beverage/food bottles, medicine bottles, non-white cosmetic bottles

Caution

Be sure to remove lids/caps and dispose of them correctly according to their symbols. Baby bottles go into **non-burnable garbage**.

Large Garbage (designated items or anything larger than 1 m)

You have 2 choices on how to dispose of large garbage.

(1) Call the Miyazaki City Call Center (☎25-2111) to request a garbage pickup.

Call Center Hours: 8:00 – 17:15 excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays

(2) You can request a garbage pickup online from the Miyazaki City website. A pickup fee is required separately.

You can request a pickup for up to three items at a time. The pickup date cannot be designated.

Purchase Home Appliance Recycling Coupons prior to pickup if disposing of recyclable home appliances.

* Restrictions may apply.

(3) Bring your large garbage to the Eco Clean Plaza Miyazaki. Dropoff requires a separate Garbage Processing Fee.

* Recyclable home appliances and other items are not accepted.

Recyclable home appliances

Air conditioners, TVs, freezers, refrigerators, washing machines, clothes dryers

Miyazaki City Garbage Collection Basic Rules

Designated bags

Set out “**burnable garbage**” and “**non-burnable garbage**” in the designated bags. There are four sizes: Large, Medium, Small, and Very Small.

Garbage collection points

Garbage collection point are managed by local authorities. To find the garbage collection point closest to you, ask your neighbors or the local authorities in your area. Do not set out garbage in plastic bins as collectors may mistake them for other purposes.

When to set out garbage

Set out your garbage in the designated collection point by 8:30 a.m. The collection time may vary due to that day’s collection schedule, the amount of garbage being collected, or for other reasons.

Amount of garbage that can be set out

You may set out up to 5 bags of garbage at a time. If you want to dispose of 6 or more bags of garbage, bring your garbage to the Eco Clean Plaza Miyazaki or ask a professional agent to dispose of them.

Recyclables

Wash and dry recyclables (plastic containers and packaging, PET bottles, empty cans and bottles, paper packaging, etc.) before setting them out for collection. The only trash bags you can use are colorless, clear bags of less than 45L or colorless, translucent shopping bags.

Do not double-bag your recyclables.

If garbage is left uncollected

Garbage that is set out in violation of these rules will be affixed with an identifying sticker and left behind. If your garbage is not collected, **take it home and set it out on the next collection day in line with the rules.**

Items that are NOT collected

Soil, sand, stones, car parts (tires, seats, bumpers, etc.), batteries, fire extinguishers, oil heaters, button batteries, Ni-Cd batteries, etc. Please inquire about these with a specialist recycler, manufacturer, or retail store.

N.B.

Non-burnable Garbage

Once a month

Pottery, glass, heat-resistant glass

Garbage with sharp parts and edges such as knives should be wrapped in paper and clearly marked as **ケケン**.

Baby bottles (Burnable if not glass)

Use until empty.

Dangerous goods

Home appliances

Please remove batteries before placing out for collection.

Other goods

Metal caps, etc.

Aluminum foil

LED fluorescent tubes

Disposable warming pads

Caution

Items that do not fit into a large bag can be taped to or covered with a **large bag**—one type of item per bag—as long as it is within one meter in length, width, and height.

Metals

Metals

Once a month

Microwave ovens, pots and pans

Remove any fuel or batteries.

An item that is less than one meter in size but does not fit into a bag can be labeled “金属類” by writing the word on a piece of paper and sticking it onto the item.

Cans and spray cans

20 cm or more

Beverage/food cans over 20 cm in any direction or diameter

Sprays cans and other non-beverage/non-food cans

Use until empty, then puncture outdoors away from any flame to drain completely.

Caution

Dispose of very rusty or dirty items as **non-burnable garbage**.

Cloth

Paper

Clothing / Paper (No collection on 5th week)

Four times a month

Clothing

Paper

Please do not use stretch wrap.

Newspaper

Cardboard

Paper packaging

Other papers

Remove any adhesive tape.

Caution

Dispose of items that are unclean, wet, or stuffed with cotton or feathers as **burnable garbage**.

Caution

On rainy collection days, place clothing and paper in clear bags so they do not get wet.

* Broken fluorescent tubes are **non-burnable garbage**

Iron dumbbells less than 10 kg

Alkaline batteries

Manganese batteries

Non-rechargeable lithium batteries

Lithium coin batteries

Caution

Button batteries, (SR, PR and LR types), small rechargeable batteries, etc. will not be collected. Please bring those types of batteries to shops, such as electronic stores, that will collect them for recycling.

Collection Points

Small home appliances

A collection box for small home appliances, such as digital cameras, is installed at municipal facilities, supermarkets, etc. For locations, scan the code to the right or contact the Miyazaki City Call Center. If you have a small appliance that does not fit into the 25 cm × 10 cm collection box opening, remove the batteries, then put it out as **non-burnable garbage**.

* Put **small rechargeable batteries (including mobile batteries), electronic cigarettes and heat-not-burn tobacco products** into the collection box for small home appliances.
