Burnable Garbage

Twice a week

Food waste

Plastic products

Leather goods

Clothing, etc.

Rubber products

Garden cuttings, leaves

Plastic items that do not display the "plastic" symbol

Garden cuttings should be no longer than 1 meter and no thicker than 12 cm in diameter.

Caution

Items that do not fit into a large bag can be taped to or covered with a large bag—one type of item per bag—as long as it is within one meter in length, width, and height. *Taping (or covering) is only allowed when using a large bag.

Plastic

Plastic containers and packaging

Once a week

Look for this symbol

Caps

Caution

Do not double-bag garbage. Unclean items should be disposed of with burnable garbage.

Twice a month

PET beverage, seasoning, sake or other food bottles

Colorless, clear bottles only

* Dispose of colored or opaque bottles as burnable garbage.

Plastic containers and packaging

Caps

Labels

Caution

Remove caps and labels. Dispose of colored or unclean bottles, and bottles with irremovable caps or labels as burnable garbage.

Cans/Bottles

Empty cans and empty bottles

Twice a month

Empty cans

Empty bottles

20 cm or less

Beverage/food cans less than 20 cm in any direction or diameter

Beverage/food bottles, medicine bottles, non-white cosmetic bottles

Metal caps, etc.

Caution

Always rinse the can or bottle clean. Remove the cap or lid so that no foreign matter remains inside and place metal lids in the same "empty cans and empty bottles" bag. *Cans or bottles with a closed lid or cap cannot be collected.

Large Garbage (designated items or anything larger than 1 m)

You have 2 choices on how to dispose of large garbage. *A pickup fee is charged for (1) and (2).

(1) Call the Miyazaki City Call Center (☎25-2111) to request a garbage pickup.

Call Center Hours: 8:00 – 17:15 excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays

(2) You can request a garbage pickup online from the Miyazaki City website.

You can request a pickup for up to three items at a time. The pickup date cannot be designated.

Pickup is not accepted for some items.

Purchase Home Appliance Recycling Coupons prior to pickup if disposing of recyclable home appliances. (Home Appliance Recycling Coupon Center ☎0120-319-640)

(3) Bring your large garbage to the Eco Clean Plaza Miyazaki (☎30-6511). Dropoff requires a separate Garbage Processing Fee.

* Recyclable home appliances and other items are not accepted.

Air conditioners, TVs, freezers, refrigerators, washing machines, clothes dryers

Seven Basic Rules for Garbage Collection in Miyazaki City

① Designated bags

Set out "burnable garbage" and "non-burnable garbage" in the designated bags. There are four sizes: Large, Medium, Small, and Very Small.

② Garbage collection points

Garbage collection point are managed by local authorities. To find the garbage collection point closest to you, ask your neighbors or the local authorities in your area. Do not set out garbage in plastic buckets or other opaque containers where the contents cannot be seen as collectors may not think it is garbage.

③ When to set out garbage

Set out your garbage in the designated collection point by 8:30 a.m. The collection time may vary due to that day's collection schedule, the amount of garbage being collected, or for other reasons.

④ Amount of garbage that can be set out

You may set out up to 5 bags of garbage at a time. If you want to dispose of 6 or more bags of garbage, bring your garbage to the Eco Clean Plaza Miyazaki or ask a professional agent to dispose of them.

⑤ Recyclables

Wash and dry recyclables (plastic containers and packaging, PET bottles, empty cans and bottles, paper packaging, etc.) before setting them out for collection. The only trash bags you can use are colorless, clear bags of less than 45L or colorless, translucent shopping bags. Do not double-bag your recyclables.

⑥ If garbage is left uncollected

Garbage that is set out in violation of these rules will be affixed with an identifying sticker and left behind. If your garbage is not collected, take it home and set it out on the next collection day in line with the rules.

⑦ Items that are NOT collected

Soil, sand, stones, car parts (tires, seats, bumpers, etc.), batteries, fire extinguishers, oil heaters, button batteries, Ni-Cd batteries, etc. Please inquire about these with a specialist recycler, manufacturer, or retail store.

N.B.

Non-burnable Garbage

Once a month

Pottery, glass, heat-resistant glass

Garbage with sharp parts and edges such as knives should be wrapped in paper and clearly marked as 危険.

Home appliances

Please remove batteries before placing out for collection.

Other goods

Aluminum foil

Disposable warming pads

Dangerous goods

Baby bottles (glass) (with all other parts that are burnable)

Use until empty.

Items larger than 1 m are considered large garbage.

LED fluorescent tubes

Caution

Items that do not fit into a large bag can be taped to or covered with a large bag—one type of item per bag—as long as it is within one meter in length, width, and height. *Taping (or covering) is only allowed when using a large bag.

Metals

Metals

Once a month

Microwave ovens, pots and pans

Remove any fuel or batteries.

An item that is less than one meter in size but does not fit into a bag can be labeled "金属類" by writing the word on a piece of paper and sticking it onto the item.

Cans and spray cans

20 cm or more

Beverage/food cans over 20 cm in any direction or diameter

Sprays cans and other non-beverage/non-food cans

Use until empty, then puncture outdoors away from any flame to drain completely.

Caution

Dispose of very rusty or dirty items as non-burnable garbage.

Cloth/Paper

Clothing and paper (No collection on 5th week)

Four times a month

Clothing

Paper

Please do not use stretch wrap. Tie up separately with string or plastic rope.

Newspaper

Cardboard

Paper packaging

Other papers

Remove any adhesive tape.

Caution

Dispose of items that are unclean, wet, or stuffed with cotton or feathers as burnable garbage.

Caution

On rainy days, place in a 45L or smaller clear bag to put out for collection.

Difficult-to-break-down items

* Broken fluorescent tubes are non-burnable garbage

Caution

Button batteries (SR, PR and LR types) will not be collected. Please bring those types of batteries to shops such as electronic stores that officially collect them.

Collection Points

Small home appliances

A collection box for small home appliances can be found at certain municipal facilities, supermarkets, etc. For locations, scan the 2D barcode to the right or contact the Miyazaki City Call Center. If you have a small appliance that does not fit into the 25 cm × 10 cm collection box opening, remove the batteries, then put it out as non-burnable garbage.

* Put small rechargeable batteries (including mobile batteries), electronic cigarettes and heat-not-burn tobacco products into the collection box for small home appliances.

* If a rechargeable battery cannot be removed from a device, inquire with the product manufacturer or retail store about collection or contact the Miyazaki City Environmental Affairs Section.

Caution

*PLEASE DO NOT put out for collection lithium-ion batteries that are used in rechargeable home appliances. They are combustible and dangerous.

Collection Points

Waste cooking oil

Waste cooking oil (vegetable oil) from households is collected at certain municipal facilities, etc. Scan the 2D barcode to the right to learn how to prepare the oil for collection or to find the locations of collection boxes.
